

Ice melt damage

- Sodium chloride, more commonly known as rock salt is one of the most widely used de-icing material around, and although its very inexpensive to purchase, it can end up being very costly in the long run.
- The rock salt mixes with snow and ice to form a brine that will run off into your mulch beds and lawn causing damage to both your shrubs and turf and will even damage your concrete.
- A turf friendly alternative is calcium chloride ice melter. Common brand names include Peladow and Road Runner.

Using calcium chloride will keep your sidewalks and driveway ice free while keeping your lawn and landscape healthy.
