2 Types of Snow Mold

"Gray Snow Mold" appears as a grayish-white matted area, and "Pink Snow Mold" has a pinkish hue on infected patches.

•Favorable conditions:

- •Long periods of snow cover
- •Cool, wet weather
- •Excessive thatch build-up
- •High nitrogen levels in late fall

•Prevention methods:

•Mowing: Mow your lawn to a shorter height before the first snow

•Fertilizer management: Apply moderate nitrogen fertilizer in fall, avoiding heavy applications close to winter

•Leaf removal: Rake up fallen leaves to prevent excessive thatch build-up

•Drainage improvement: Ensure good drainage to prevent water accumulation

•Snow management: Avoid creating large snow drifts on your lawn
